My role is to ensure homepage goals are met on time, solutions are scalable and easy to use, and design standards are met. I'm partnering with UX, merchandising, engineering, product, and advertising leads to meet marketing-driven deadlines and improve the brand experience for our travelers.

Program: Covid-19 response and recovery

Established a cross-functional review process to vet COVID-19 content and designs before handoff to engineering. Prior to this process, content was released to production too quickly and without sufficient quality checks, which resulted in conflicting and confusing information for travelers. The new process ensured that designs were approved by public relations and legal experts, leveraged our Universal Design

My role was to educate technical and non-technical stakeholders on the benefits of adopting the new platform and consult on approaches to tackling this complex task. Also created materials for and conducted worldwide “roadshow” presentations to individual teams.

Built accessible, scalable, components for Expedia’s User Interface Toolkit (UITK) using React, HTML, Sass, Enzyme, and Git. UITK components are used on over 90% of Expedia pages worldwide, including partner sites. In addition to building components, I

- provided front-end technical support to developers via code reviews, education, and troubleshooting.
- documented various configurations for components and provided usage guidelines.
- interviewed internal and external job applicants for technical and soft skills.
- conducted performance audits of the site.
